Cover note:

The success of our Club is dependent on the trust and confidence we earn from our Club members. We gain credibility by adhering to our commitments, displaying honesty and integrity and reaching our clubs goals solely through honorable conduct. We must not just talk the talk but walk the walk as well.

CODE

As an elected Board Member representing the Corporation and its members, it is expected that you will be a positive role model for parents, players, coaches, and members. Board members may be held to a higher standard by members.

The following expectations are set for all Board Members:

- Sign and adhere to the USAI Parent Pledge & Code of Conduct.

- No Board Member shall share, copy, reproduce, transmit, divulge, or otherwise disclose any confidential information related to the affairs of the Corporation. Each member of the Board will uphold the strict confidentiality of member registration information and email addresses as well as of meetings and other deliberations and communications of the Board of Directors. Note: Except as the Board may otherwise require or as otherwise required by law.

- All grievances or issues among or between Board members should be discussed within the confines of the USAI Board Room meetings. Everyone should feel comfortable to speak his or her mind within these meetings. If needed, a resolution will be sought with an unbiased third party.

- Verbal, written (including email and all social media), physical or visual harassment of any member of the Club or the Club itself will not be tolerated. Please see separate Board policies referenced below.

- Upon termination of service, a retiring Board member will promptly return to the Corporation all documents, electronic and hard files, reference materials, and other property entrusted to the Board member for the purpose of fulfilling his or her job responsibilities. Such return will not abrogate the retiring Board member from his or her continuing obligations of confidentiality with respect to information acquired as a consequence of his or her tenure on the Board of directors.

Note:

Should the Parent Code of Conduct be signed during player registration, only Board members without a currently enrolled child need sign a separate document.
