

Scheduling League Games at USA of Indiana Fields

When you are scheduling or rescheduling games, or when you attend the team's league scheduling meeting, ideally with Coach, but at a minimum with Coach's personal calendar avails:

Please be sure you only schedule games when USA OF INDIANA fields are open to host the game.

When you attempt to schedule when USA OF INDIANA fields are closed, your good work may be wasted, as the league will reject the game. Then one must start the scheduling process anew for those games and the process becomes slow and cumbersome via email and phone; instead of the ease of “sitting” next to the opponent at the scheduling meeting. Plus your preferred dates may now be unavailable with the opponent.

Spring 2024 HOSTING MEMO

Here is the information on when USA of Indiana fields may be scheduled for travel and Rec Plus home games. CNC small sided games are scheduled by league on match days.

Fields are closed for games until 4/16/2024.

Fields are open for games from 4/16/2024 through 6/2/2024

Fields are closed Memorial Day weekend 5/24, 5/25, 5/26, 5/27.

The primary fields to use at Mary & John Geisse Soccer Complex:

11v11: Field 1 or 3

9v9: Field 5 or 6

USA of Indiana - Avon Soccer Complex & USA of Indiana - Brownsburg Soccer Complex

Host on ANY day, noon-6pm start times.

The primary fields to use at USA of Indiana - Brownsburg Soccer Complex:

11v11: field 62

9v9: field 65

The primary fields to use at USA of Indiana - Avon Soccer Complex:

11v11: field 82

9v9: field 84

Holiday and Tournament Closures – NO Games:

CLOSED Indy Burn Cup: April 11 – 14, 2024

Do not schedule league games during IBC **unless** the opponent is playing IBC24 and agrees to count a tournament game also as a league game.
